On the back side of this worksheet is another worksheet to help you determine the cost of tuition and fees, books, lap-top leases and tools.

WORKSHEET FOR DETERMINING DIRECT COSTS OF ATTENDANCE AT ATCC

TUITION AND FEES PER CREDIT: If you have registered for classes, the Business Office will have the actual amount of tuition and fees for your enrollment at ATCC. Once you have a user ID and password to myATC, you can access your tuition statement on-line. If you register for classes at other campuses, you will need to contact them for actual costs. If you are not a Minnesota resident and do not qualify for reciprocity, you will have additional tuition charges. Contact the admissions office if you are uncertain. Otherwise, use the following worksheet for estimating tuition and fees.

Classroom: (\$160.55 and \$18.71) = \$179.26 X # of credits _____ = \$ _____

On-Line: (\$199.00 and \$10.31) = \$209.31 X # of credits _____ = \$ _____

Other campuses: contact them for estimates. \$ _____

Out of State with no reciprocity – additional charges \$ _____

Differentiated tuition – additional charges \$ _____

Differentiated tuition rates apply to 16 courses: Law Enforcement Skills courses are \$214.77 per credit. Law Enforcement Skills courses at St Cloud State are \$225.14 per credit. AAS Skills courses are \$239.08 per credit.

Four courses in the Computer area, 6 courses in Nursing, 4 courses in Concrete Masonry, 4 courses in Machine Tool range from \$187.26 to \$197.10 per credit plus fees. 1 course in Truck Driving range is \$298.13 per credit plus fees.

BOOKS: Once you have registered, the bookstore can estimate your book costs more accurately if you intend to buy your books at the ATCC bookstore. You can purchase your books anywhere. Book costs cover a wide range depending on program and number of credits for which you enroll. Following is a best estimate:

Part-time (12 to 22 credits per year) = \$200 to \$800 \$ _____

Full-time (23 to 50 credits per year) = \$800 to \$1200 \$ _____

LAP-TOP LEASE IF REQUIRED

Varies by program: \$375 to \$435 per semester \$ _____

TOOLS: Varies by program – quantity and quality will determine cost. The programs requiring the most expense for tools will schedule a ‘tool day’ with vendors who provide discounts to students.

Tool costs vary from \$250 to as much as \$6000. \$ _____
