Moped Course

The four-hour, classroom-only moped course is a great introduction to riding. The course is required for those who do not have a driver's license, are at least 15 years of age, and wish to ride a moped on the street. See legal information below.

Legal Information

Anyone with a driver's license may legally ride a moped on the street.

A moped is a vehicle that is propelled by a motor of a capacity of 50cc or less, and a maximum of two brake horse power, which is capable of a maximum speed of not more than 30 mph on a flat surface.

Anyone who holds either a drivers license or a motorized bicycle permit is eligible to operate a moped.

Anyone 15 years old wishing to obtain a motorized bicycle permit must:

- Complete an approved course (the course can be completed before the rider turns 15 years old)
- Present completion card to examiner to take written and riding test (permit is void after obtaining drivers license.)

Racial/Ethnic Origin Descriptions

American Indian or Alaska Native - A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South American (including Central America) who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community attachment.
