The 10% applies to all highways during the Winter Load Increase (WLI). During WLI a permit for these increases is needed only when operating on an Interstate Highway.

The 10% is also valid for the Harvest Increase for **potatoes, sugarbeets, and carrots** from the beginning of harvest to November 30th. When used as a harvest increase it is valid only on State Trunk Highways, and requires a DOT Permit. The Harvest permit is NOT valid for movement on Interstate Highways. **Tire ratings cannot be exceeded in either increase.**

Single unit milk trucks by permit. (Special conditions)

Two consecutive tandems may carry a gross weight of 37,400 lbs each and a total of 74,800 lbs together, when the centers of the first and last axle of the group are spaced 36 feet or more.
