Riders spend all of their time riding on a course. Breaks are provided throughout the course.

The Intermediate Rider Course covers:

- ◇ Cornering
- ◇ Counter steering
- ◇ Emergency braking
- ◇ Swerving
- ◇ Tight turns
- ◇ Low-speed control
- ◇ Decreasing radius curves
- ◇ Stopping in a curve

There are no tests in this course.

# Eligibility Requirements

Participants ride their own motorcycle during the course.

Motorcycles must be street legal, licensed, insured and pass a basic inspection.

Riders must show proof of insurance to the instructor.

Riders must have a valid driver's license with either a motorcycle endorsement or a valid motorcycle permit.

Riders must be proficient in the basic skills of clutch control, straight-line riding, turning, shifting and stopping.

Riders are required to bring a completed waiver form to participate in this course.

Participants under 18 must have their parents sign a waiver form prior to on-cycle instruction.

Riders must be comfortable on their own motorcycle.

## Riders must wear:

- ◇ DOT-approved helmet
- ◇ Eye protection
- ◇ Long sleeves
- ◇ Long pants
- ◇ Full-fingered gloves
- ◇ Over-the-ankle footwear

Students are strongly encouraged to bring rain gear — courses run rain or shine.
