Recommendations

Review the 22 skills listed in the Candidate Handbook on pages 24–38, paying special attention to bolded critical steps.

The Day of the Exam

- Arrive 15-30 minutes early
- Parking available in the North Parking Lot or Visitor Parking. Parking permits required.

Attire Requirements (You will need to act as a candidate volunteer for another nurse aide's Skills Evaluation and play the role of a nursing home patient (client).

- Short sleeve shirt (underneath sweater/sweatshirt is acceptable)
- Easy to slip on and off shoes
- Socks
- Clothing and personal hygiene should meet industry healthcare standards. The Evaluator reserves the right to refuse testing if these standards are not met.

Individuals (candidates) interested in becoming a certified nursing assistant can now challenge the competency exam for placement on the Minnesota Nursing Assistant Registry. The two-part exam, the Written Examination and the Skills Evaluation, will be administered on the same day. You must pass both parts in order to be certified and listed on the Minnesota Nursing Assistant Registry.

The Written Examination consists of seventy (70) multiple-choice questions written in English (oral test available by request).

During the Skills Evaluation, you will be asked to perform five (5) randomly selected nursing assistant skills. You will be given thirty (30) minutes to complete five skills. You will be observed/rated by an Evaluator. To review these skills, a Candidate Handbook will be provided to you at no charge.

You MUST have the following items with you when you take your exam or you will not be able to test!

- **Two (2) forms of official, signature-bearing identification** (one form of which must be photo-bearing), such as Driver's License, Passport, State-issued identification card. **All ID cards MUST be signed.** Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted.
- **Social Security number** (*SS card or documentation with number on it*)
- **Three (3) No. 2 pencils** (*sharpened*)
- **Watch with second hand**

Exam

If you have recently completed a training which includes home health aide, please contact our office at the number below so that a NA HHA written exam can be ordered for you. We will need a copy of your certificate of completion and a completed Application Form from your instructor.

Accommodations for the written tests can be made for students with a current Individual Education Plan (IEP) through the school system with a disability diagnosis from health provider.

- Persons who are English Language Learners (ELL) are not considered disabled and must take the unit tests in writing to assure deliverance of safe care.
- Training programs are taught in English only, translation is not allowed.
