#### Add/Drop Week

- ADDING A COURSE
  - » The deadline to add a course is Friday, August 30th
- DROPPING A COURSE
  - » The deadline to drop a course is **Monday, Sept. 9**<sup>th</sup>
    - Must See the PSEO Dept to drop a course
  - Not showing up is not dropping a course, and will result in a Failure for nonattendance
  - » **Policy:** Course Add, Drop, & Withdrawal (<u>3.10.1</u>)
  - » Policy: Refunds, Waivers, and Withdrawals (<u>5.12.2</u>)

## SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP)

- Two components:
  - » *Qualitative*: Students must maintain a **2.0 cumulative grade point** average (GPA) at all times.
  - Quantitative: Students must complete with a passing grade at least
     66.67% of their cumulative registered credits (W, FW, or F = not passing).
- If a PSEO student ends up on a warning status, they will be required to complete an appeal to take courses the following semester.



## WITHDRAWAL (W) & FAILURE TO WITHDRAW (FW)

- Contact the PSEO Advisor before withdrawing from a course.
- A Withdrawal affects percent completion.
- Do Not just stop attending or participating in class.
   Instructors will enter a grade of FW after a certain number of missed classes or assignments. FW calculates the same as F.
- FW affects both GPA and percent completion.



#### **High School vs College**

- Coursework involves more independent work outside of the classroom
- Expect to spend 2 hours outside of the classroom on homework for each class (less classroom time for homework)
- Instructors may not remind you of upcoming assignments or tests
- Full responsibility for managing time and assignments



#### **Student Rights and Conduct**

- Student Rights and Responsibilities
  - » ATCC promotes freedom of expression but must comply with college policies, procedures, and regulations
  - » Cell phones, camera phones, and digital cameras during supervised classroom sessions and in specific areas of the college are prohibited.
  - » Policy: Student Rights & Responsibilities (3.1)
- Student Code of Conduct
  - » ATCC students must always conduct themselves in a respectful and professional manner, as failure to do so may result in student discipline.
  - » Policy: Student Code of Conduct (3.6)
- Student Complaints & Grievances
  - » Permits students to address concerns through informal or formal channels
  - » Policy: Student Complaints & Grievances (3.8)



#### Release of Information

- Your student and personal data are protected under FERPA.
- If you want to grant access to your academic and financial information, you will need to authorize them through <u>MyATCC\Student Forms\Authorization to Release Student</u> Information
  - » The authorization is valid for one calendar year
- Policy: Student Directory Information (2.5)



#### **Address or Name Change**

- Address changes can be done online through eServices\Account Management\Name & Address Info
- Legal name changes must be done through the Welcome Center with legal documentation
- Preferred name changes can be done online through eServices\Account Management\Name & Address Info.



#### **Emergency Notifications**

- In the event of an emergency, a <u>Star Alert</u> text message will be sent to your cell number and/or email
- Fire Evacuation Plans and Severe Weather Plans are posted in every classroom



#### **Safety and Security**

- Safety and Security Compliance


