DEGREE PLAN

- Upon verification of eligibility, active military or veterans will be granted up to 2 credits for their military coursework and training.
- Additional college credit may be granted for:
 - other military courses with a Joint Service Transcript (JST) or Community College of the Air Force Transcript (CCAF)
 - courses from other colleges/ universities upon review of an official transcript
 - ACE Military Guide
 recommendations
- A minimum of 1/3 of the credits must be taken at NTC.
