TRANSFER CREDITS GRANTED

CREDITS NEEDED TO GRADUATE

DETAILS:

- Upon verification of eligibility, active military or veterans will be granted up to 17 credits for their METC coursework and training.
- Credit determinations were made using current METC curriculum course dates. For questions, please contact the receiving institution for review of your training.
- A minimum of 1/3 of the credits must be taken at NTC.
- Additional college credit may be granted for:
 - other military courses with a Joint Service Transcript (JST) or Community College of the Air Force Transcript (CCAF)
 - courses from other colleges/ universities upon review of an official transcript
 - ACE Military Guide recommendations
