This GMLN Military Bridge is offered to members of the United States military who have completed one of the eligible military occupational trainings, and are ranked E5 or higher. Service members who have completed this occupational training, E-5 or higher, can earn 20 credits towards the History Transfer Pathway AA at Northland Community & Technical College.
