### **STANDARD BRIDGE**

This GMLN Military Bridge is offered to members of the United States military who have completed one of the eligible military occupational trainings. Service members who have completed this occupational training, of any rank, can earn 17 credits towards the Sociology Transfer Pathway AA at Northland Community & Technical College.

### E5+ BRIDGE

This GMLN Military Bridge is offered to members of the United States military who have completed one of the eligible military occupational trainings, and are ranked E5 or higher. Service members who have completed this occupational training, E-5 or higher, can earn 20 credits towards the Sociology Transfer Pathway AA at Northland Community & Technical College.

#### **DETAILS:**

- Upon verification of eligibility, active military or veterans will be granted up to 17 credits for their military coursework and training.
- To earn a degree from one of our Minnesota State colleges or universities, a minimum number of credits must be taken through the institution, typically 30 credits for bachelor's degrees, 15 credits for associate degrees, and 1/3 of the total credits for diplomas and certificates.
   Some programs may vary.
- Additional college credit may be granted for:
  - other military courses with a Joint Service Transcript (JST) or Community College of the Air Force Transcript (CCAF)
  - courses from other colleges/ universities upon review of an official transcript
  - ACE Military Guide recommendations
