DETAILS:

- To earn a degree from Alexandria Technical & Community College (ATCC), a minimum of 15 credits must be taken through ATCC.
- Additional college credit may be granted for:
 - other military courses with a Joint Service Transcript (JST) or Community College of the Air Force Transcript (CCAF)
 - courses from other colleges/ universities upon review of an official transcript
 - ACE Military Guide
