



To be considered for acceptance into the Law Enforcement program at Alexandria Technical & Community College, prospective students are required to complete the following steps.

Applicants are conditionally accepted into the Law Enforcement Program upon passing their Background Check.

Students will complete a psychological exam during the first week of class their second year.

- Provide high school and **OFFICIAL** college transcripts from all institutions the applicant has attended (with the exception of any Minnesota State institutions attended after 1990).

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In order to pass this evaluation, applicants must successfully meet or exceed the minimum standards of 4 out of 5 agility tests listed below. Multiple attempts to pass the test are allowed (one attempt per testing date).

### MINIMUM STANDARDS:

#### MEN:

- 1 pull-up
- 42 sit-ups
- 25 push-ups
- Obstacle Course:
  - 57 sec. or less
- 500 Yard Run:
  - 2 min. 25 sec. or less

#### WOMEN:

- 1 modified pull-up
- 41 sit-ups
- 10 push-ups
- Obstacle Course:
  - 61 sec. or less
- 500 Yard Run:
  - 2 min. 30 sec. or less

Remember that the physical agility test is strenuous and will demonstrate to the applicant the degree of physical conditioning required to successfully complete the program's physical education requirements.

### PULL-UPS (MEN: 1 pull-up, WOMEN: 1 modified pull-up)

Male applicants will start from a position in which their arms are fully extended and palms are facing away; they will then pull themselves up until their chin is parallel with the bar before returning to the extended position. Female applicants will complete a modified pull-up by having their feet on the ground and keeping their back straight while pulling themselves up until the chest is even with the bar before returning to the start position.

### TIMED SIT-UPS (in 60 seconds, MEN: 42, WOMEN: 41)

Applicants, on the floor with arms folded across the chest, will execute a sit-up by touching their elbows to their knees before going back down until their shoulder blades touch the floor. Applicants will do as many sit-ups as possible in the 1 minute limit.

### PUSH-UPS (MEN: 25, WOMEN: 10)

This test measures the muscle endurance in the upper body. Applicants will start with their hands a shoulder width apart on the ground, their feet no more than twelve inches apart, and their body in a straight line from the shoulders to the ankles. They must keep their back straight throughout the exercise. Applicants will lower their body by bending their elbows until their upper arms are at least at a 90-degree bend, keeping their back straight at all times. Applicants will then return to the starting position by straightening their arms. They may rest in the starting position.

### TIMED OBSTACLE COURSE (MEN: 57 seconds, WOMEN: 61 seconds)

Applicants will be timed as they maneuver around, over, and under obstacles by running, jumping, climbing, carrying, and crawling. Obstacles include jumping hurdles, moving a 165 lb. mannequin 15 yards, and scaling a 6 foot wall.

### TIMED 500 YARD RUN (MEN: 2 min. 25 sec., WOMEN: 2 min. 30 sec.)

Applicants will run a 500 yard course without stopping. The course is 25 yards down and 25 yards back to equal 10 laps.
